



project GEODISIC DOME! by Eve Olsen




INSTRUCTIONS



Take 10 green straws and cut each straw into three 6cm pieces.


Take 18 blue straws and cut each straw into two 7cm pieces.

Take 32 green pipe-cleaners and cut each pipe-cleaner into four equal pieces.
Put all your pieces into separate containers.




Make a °V' shape with two green straws bend a pipe-cleaner in half and connect the °V' shape at the pointed end.


Keep adding green straws in the same way until you have a five-sided star.




Connect the points of the green stars by using the blue straws using two bent pipe-cleaners at each point. You should now have a pentagon shape. Make six of these pentagons.




Connect two pentagons together at one point using two pipe-cleaners.




Connect the gap between the pentagons with two blue straws.




Connect the other three pentagons to these two pentagons. The five pentagons will start to form a curve. Connect the two end points together in a circle shape.



Add a blue straw at the bottom of the dome to close the gap between the two pentagons you have just joined together.




You should have one pentagon left over which will fit in the gap of the dome. Remove the blue straws-leaving the pipe-cleaners sticking out-use these paip-cleaners to connect the last pentagon to the dome.




Decide what you would like your dome to be. It could be an igloo, a fruit bowl or just a fun shape! use cloured card to draw objects to fill your dome.


